





Improving impact is not serendipity. It is a result of continuous pushing of the envelope by people involved in thinking about improving ourselves. We have been blessed to have a dedicated team, a very thoughtful and knowledgeable Board of Advisors who have been giving more and more time to the efforts of BECT. What has been heartwarming in the increasing time, is the commitment from volunteers, advisors and mentors over the years. These include friends on the ground in Bhilai and those scattered around the world after their formative years in Bhilai.

We are also humbled to receive three precious awards for the work we have been doing for over 8 years now.

A quick look at the total time invested over the period is indicative of what it has taken us to get here. It is equivalent of ~4 years of full-time effort by an individual.



In my opinion, we are just getting started. There is a very long way to go, and we would like this to soon get to ~10 years equivalent of work, each year that requires significant scaling on both dedicated team as well as volunteers and mentors.

We have also gradually increased the total spends for the Trust over time. However, if we intend to significantly deepen our efforts and impact, we need a step change in funding availability too. We are making efforts to expand the donor base and every contribution from you will help. We are hoping to reach out to greater number of alumni from Bhilai schools around the world and find many with whom this cause of giving back to the city resonates. JEE NEET PROGRAM

We are providing the best coaching at IIT-Medical Zone, Bhilai and sponsoring the coaching fees of Rs 25,000 per student per course. They are being prepared for JEE/NEET entrance examinations. Students enrolled - 40.

Our mentoring program is one of its kind that connects students with their chosen mentors globally to share their experiences and guidance. We are proud that now we have more than 50 streams of education covered by our different mentors.


